



BURSARY 2022 COMPETITION RULES

1. The competition is open to all people over 18 years of age on 1st September 2022 who were born or who currently reside in the island of Ireland.
2. Each entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the competition and to accept all decisions of the adjudicators.
3. The competition is open to solo performers of any musical genre.
4. Entries must be submitted by e-mail to wmvcbursary@gmail.com by 28th October 2022.
5. Former winners of this competition are not eligible to enter again.
6. Own composition will not be accepted.
7. Each entrant must include with his/her entry form a Reference from a person associated with his/her musical achievements.
8. Each entrant must include with his/her entry form an audio or video recording of one piece for consideration. Professional studio recordings will not be accepted.
9. The prize consists of Bursary of €3,000 (Three Thousand Euro) and a guest appearance at our Christmas Concert in St. Patrick's Church, Wicklow Town on Sunday 11th December 2022.
10. The adjudicators, at their absolute discretion, will select entrants from the submitted entries to perform in the competition.
11. All entrants will be notified of their selection or otherwise. The final of the competition will be a public performance on Saturday 19th November 2022 at 3pm in The De La Salle Pastoral Centre, St. Patrick's Road, Wicklow Town, A67FX65.
12. The decision of the adjudicators will be binding in all circumstances.
13. Each entrant must, if required, supply his/her own accompanist.
14. On the competition night each finalist will introduce and perform two contrasting pieces not to exceed 10 minutes duration in total.
15. By submitting an entry form, each entrant authorizes the use of his/her name, photo, audio and/or video for publicity and advertisement purposes related to the competition and The Wicklow Male Voice Choir.
16. The Bursary may be used by the award winner for attendance at a recognised place of tuition, a course of study (in Ireland or abroad), or on a purchase deemed necessary to assist in the development of his/her talent.
17. Dress on competition final night shall be appropriate for the occasion.
18. All data received will be dealt with in accordance with General Data Protection Regulations.
